As bass anglers feverishly fished for a place in Provincial/Divisional Bass teams over the long weekend (March 19th and 20th) - conditions proved super tough with disappointing catches - and this time they really can blame it on the moon!

The unusual super-full moon which was ultra bright caused the fishing to be extra tough and fewer bass were caught during competitions - held at Theewaterskloof Dam (Cape) and Midmar Dam (KZN) respectively.

Many of the fish caught did not make the size limit of 300mm and were released to grow larger.

Marc Bywater of Bayside Bass Club weighed in five fish (during their one-day event) to win in the Cape with 9.88pts. Club Marine sponsored angler Craig Fraser (Western Divisional President) retained his

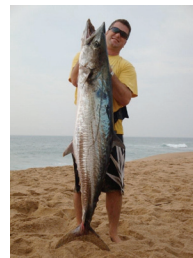
second place overall for the current season.
